AAWC SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

The Asian American Women's Coalition (AAWC) established a scholarship program in 1996 to provide financial support to female Asian American high school seniors who are preparing to go to college. The AAWC's Scholarship Selection Committee selects recipients based on academic achievement, financial need, and community service.

Initially funded by member contributions, the scholarship program has gained support from various donors and allowed AAWC to increase the number of scholarship recipients through the years. From 1996 to 2023, and even during the pandemic, AAWC has awarded scholarship assistance to 344 Asian American female high school graduates worth over \$850,000.

In 2023, the AAWC Scholarship Committee, led by Katherine Ngee and Gloria Yu, received 24 applications from 16 schools. The AAWC Board approved the recommendation of the Scholarship Committee to award scholarships to 20 graduating high school seniors. Four (4) students will receive a 4-year scholarship grant, and 16 students will receive a one-time merit award.

A unique feature of the AAWC scholarship program is the opportunity available to past scholars and student-led groups to support a college-bound student. Notably, Christina Maria Kong, a recipient of the 2007 AAWC scholarship, has supported five (5) students since 2018. The Filipino Intercultural Society of Drexel University and Calla Lily Alpha Sigma Rho at Temple University have raised funds for their AAWC scholars since 2013 and 2015, respectively. The University of Pennsylvania Philippine Association is supporting a scholar this year. AAWC members provide a matching contribution to student-funded support.

2023 David Gitter Memorial Scholar

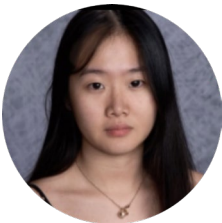

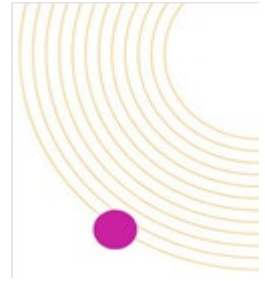

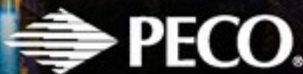
