The Cecilia Moy Yep Scholarship Fund was established in 1994 by the Asian American Women's Coalition to recognize female Asian American high school students who have made a positive and lasting impact on our local community through their service and leadership. The scholarship will help finance post-high school education. Multiple scholarships are awarded each year in varying amounts.

Scholarship Application Eligibility Requirements

Students who meet the following criteria are eligible to apply for a scholarship:

- Asian American Female high school 12th grade student graduating in May/June 2021.
- Live in Philadelphia, Delaware, Montgomery, Chester, or Bucks counties.
- Demonstrate financial need.
- Participate in community service and extracurricular activities.
- Minimum 3.0 cumulative grade point average on a 4.0 scale.
- Start college/university in Summer/Fall 2021.

All students selected for a scholarship must attend the AAWC Scholarship Celebration which will be held in early June 2021. At this time, we are planning a virtual celebration.
