AAWC SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

The Asian American Women's Coalition (AAWC) established a scholarship program in 1996 to provide financial support to female Asian American high school seniors who are preparing to go to college. The AAWC's Scholarship Selection Committee selects recipients based on academic achievement, financial need, and community service.

Initially funded by member contributions, the scholarship program has gained support from various donors and allowed AAWC to increase the number of scholarship recipients through the years. Since 1996, AAWC has awarded over \$750,000 in scholarship assistance to 300 Asian American female high school graduates.

To support its Scholarship program, AAWC established a Scholar Development Committee to monitor the progress of AAWC scholars, provide mentoring, and initiate networking opportunities among the scholars.

In 2022, the AAWC Board approved the recommendation of the Scholarship Committee to award scholarships to 24 applicants. Of the 24 scholarship recipients, six (6) will have 4-year scholarships and 18 will receive a one-time merit award. This year, AAWC also established the Edward McBride Memorial Scholarship to honor the memory of the late Edward McBride, former Manager of External Affairs at PECO, and a friend to AAWC.

Kathy Ngee and Gloria Yu led the AAWC Scholarship Committee in 2022.

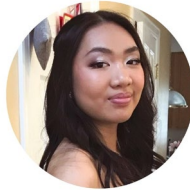

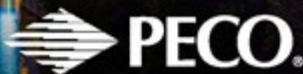
