The scholarships support post-high school education but does not include graduate studies. Multiple scholarships are awarded each year in varying amounts.

Scholarship Application Eligibility Requirements

Students who meet the following criteria are eligible to apply for a scholarship:

- Asian American Female high school 12th grade student graduating in May/June 2024.
- Live in one of the following Pennsylvania counties: Philadelphia, Delaware, Montgomery, Chester, or Bucks.
- Demonstrates Financial Need
- Participate in community service, extracurricular activities, and/or work.
- Minimum 3.0 cumulative grade point average on a 4.0 scale.
- Start college/university in Summer/Fall 2024.

All students selected for a scholarship must attend the AAWC Scholarship Celebration in May/June 2024.
