The Cecilia Moy Yep Scholarship Fund was established in 1994 by the Asian American Women's Coalition to recognize female Asian American high school students who have made a positive and lasting impact on our local community through their service and leadership. The scholarships support post-high school education but not graduate studies. Multiple scholarships are awarded each year in varying amounts.

Scholarship Application Eligibility Requirements

Students who meet the following criteria are eligible to apply for a scholarship:

- Asian American Female high school 12th grade student graduating in May/June 2025.
- Live in one of the following Pennsylvania counties: Philadelphia, Delaware, Montgomery, Chester, or Bucks'
- Demonstrates Financial Need
- Participate in community service, extracurricular activities, and/or work.
- Minimum 3.0 cumulative grade point average on a 4.0 scale.
- Start college/university in Summer/Fall 2025.

All students awarded a scholarship must attend the AAWC Scholarship Banquet tentatively scheduled for the evening of Thursday, June 5, 2025, in Philadelphia, PA.

- CSS PROFILE or FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) Student Aid Report Printout
- PHOTO (optional)
- PDF documents preferred.
- Incomplete applications will not be considered.
